The Vincennes Catholic Schools offer several scholarships, grants, and awards to students. This is a breakdown of the types of scholarships, grants, and awards available. To apply, complete the application and submit it with your tax information and enrollment form.

Indiana School Choice Scholarship & SGO (Tax Credit Scholarship)

The Indiana School Choice Scholarship and SGO are need-based programs provided through the state of Indiana. Scholarships are given based on the income limits listed below. You will need to submit a copy of your 1040 tax form with your enrollment form to apply for either type of scholarship.

The SGO currently awards \$500 per student in K-12 and \$250 per student in pre-k. The amount covered by the voucher is based on the per student state funding rate for the student's school corporation of residence, determined as 90% of the funding formula amount if household size is up to 300% of Federal Free and Reduced Lunch eligibility.

Christian Educational Foundation Grant

Each year, the CEF accepts applications for grants to assist with the cost of tuition for the Vincennes Catholic School students. Grant funds are limited and the amount available is determined by the annual CEF budget. The grant program is meant to assist students who have true financial need or special circumstances which may cause hardship or even an inability to access Catholic education due to finances or budgetary restrictions. The grant is for one full school year and applies to tuition only. Pre-K grant requests do not qualify.

Out-of-State Scholarship

This scholarship is available to students from multi-student families whose primary residence is outside of the state of Indiana, which makes them ineligible for an Indiana School Choice Scholarship or SGO. To apply for this scholarship, complete the application with your 1040 tax return as well as information about non-taxable income and other relevant financial information. Submit this application with your enrollment form. Once your application is reviewed and a scholarship amount is determined, you will set up a payment plan through our bookkeeping office for your remaining balance. Please contact the office if you need any help understanding or completing your application. Scholarships are limited; apply by May 21, 2024, for priority consideration.

Patriot Scholarship

This scholarship is for students from multi-student families requesting additional consideration beyond a School Choice Scholarship, SGO, or CEF grant or those who do not qualify for other scholarships listed. To apply for this award, complete the application with your 1040 tax return as well as information about non-taxable income and other relevant financial information. Submit this application with your enrollment form. Once your application is reviewed and an award amount is determined, you will set up a payment plan through our bookkeeping office for your remaining balance. Please contact the office if you need any help understanding or completing your application. Awards are limited; apply by May 21, 2024, for priority consideration.
